

NOTTAWA TOWNSHIP MEETING

JULY 7TH, 2014

Supervisor Called meeting to order at 6:55 p.m. with the pledge of allegiance. All members were present.

Gross made motion to accept the minutes. Green 2nd. Approved.

Local Gov: Commissioner Green informed us of the veterans who were qualified for property tax exemptions. Gordon Embs also helped explain.

Dave Livermore informed us of a grant given to Isabella county for roads amounting to about 2.3 million. Road work had to have been in the works for this grant. We had planned on fixing Winn Rd from Baseline to Weidman and Weidman road from Winn to Woodruff and now these projects will be taken care of with the grant money.

Green talked to Tony and Pat at the road commission about a 2 inch overlay on Nottawa road from Rosebush to Denver. It should cost around \$90,000. Green made a motion to have this done not to exceed \$100,000. Gross 2nd. Approved.

Gross made a motion to put 3 inches of gravel on 3 tenths of road on Gross Drive with the highest clay amount in gravel. We will purchase this gravel from McNeilly not to exceed \$9000. Green 2nd. Approved

The board passed resolution 7-7-2014 to hold July BOR, for correction of clerical errors and mutual mistakes of fact, on July 24th, 2014 at 6 p.m. Schumacher and Gross made the motion. Roll call vote. All ayes.

Treasurer's Report: Green stated that there is \$3202.96 in checking, \$199,782.05 in savings and \$150,000 in cd's. Schumacher presented bills to be paid. Gross made motion, Green 2nd. Approved.

Fire Dept: Gross announced that their meeting will be this Thurs. July 10th. Their audit takes place on Tues. July 8th. They will be having a pancake breakfast this Sat from 7 to 11.

Constables Report: none

Public Comment: none

Old Business: The safety railing on the ball fields is complete and Schumacher will take care of the grant for this.

New Business: A complaint about the drainage in Beal City was discussed. It is the homeowners place to take care of this.

The tennis netting at the park will be taken out. It is a safety hazard the way it is. Mindel will see about looking at the cost to repave the court for basketball which gets quite a bit of action.

Gross moved to adjourn at 8:20. Fox 2nd. Next meeting will be Aug.4.
