Schumacher gave report on consumer lights. Mindel will call them about the cost of changing the lights. Green made a motion to accept LED light changes up to \$20,000. Schumacher 2nd. Approved.

New Business: Mindel announced that he will be not be here for the Jan. meeting. Schumacher will head the meeting. The Feb. meeting will be changed to the 2nd Monday, Feb. 8.
