**Old Business: A question was asked about our street lights. Schumacher will look into that.**

**George Green sprayed the park lot and will also take care of that in the spring.**

**Mindel met with the Ecoli AdHoc committee on Oct 18, 2016. Carrie Parquette from the tribe handles environmental issues. The AD Hoc committee is waiting for the results from the DEQ. They asked us to look for a solution. They are pushing for a Point Of Sale Isabella county wide. They meet again in Dec. Not all of the test results have come in. Most of the contamination is in the North Branch.**

**New Business: The park is shut down for the winter.**
