Fire Report: Green announced that the fire dept received a grant for 2 single band radios in amount of \$6000. The new fire truck won't be ready til Feb.

Fox made a motion to have Pete Lorenz do a feasibility study and make a conceptual plan on ways to fix the problem. Green 2nd. Approved. The board decided that we should start making headway before the DEQ comes in.

New Business: 2% distribution from the tribe came. We received \$47,933.60 for new radios.

Green explained that the county was trying to get all the treasurer's on the same software company BSNA. It will cost \$2890 for the switch for the treasurer. Schumacher made motion to switch, Fox 2nd. Approved

Mindel welcomed Yvonne Fox to the board as trustee.
