Fox made motion to keep Isabella bank as our financial institution, Cutting Edge as our lawn maintenance and Garth Sherman as our sexton, Raising the hall rental to \$50, keeping our agreement with the K of C for dumpster rental and ball field lease, keeping our maintenance people at the park, our mileage at the same rate of .50 per mile, raising the election workers wage to \$10. per hour. Paying Zion Lutheran for the cemetery. Marchiando 2nd. All ayes
